Conditions of Entry

- 1. Meet will be swum long course under SNZ/World Aquatics rules and local rules.
- 2. All events will be swum as timed finals, with over the top starts.
- 3. This meet is open to financial Swimming New Zealand (SNZ) registered competitive swimmers (including para swimmers) aged 12 years & over as at date of meet. Overseas competitors may compete subject to providing a signed Travel Authorisation Form/Letter from their national federation.
- 4.All times must be held on the SNZ database. Converted times are permissible. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping rules.
- 5. No qualifying times required, but swimmers must hold a time in database for all swims except for one (1) 'No Time' (NT) allowed. 1500m freestyle swimmers with NT must have a 400m freestyle time in the SNZ database.
- 6.1500m freestyle (mixed) is limited to fastest 20 entries.
- 7. Entries open 24 February 2025 at 8:00am, closing at 11:59am on Monday 24 March 2025. Entries through the SNZ database only. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 8. Entry fee for each event will be \$14 (GST Incl.) Payment must be made at the time of entry via SNZ, using credit or debit card.
- 9. Self-marshalling will operate throughout.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries.
- 11. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close.
- 12. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swimming Wellington or host Clubs in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy. Club photographers should seek prior approval from the Meet organiser prior to the start of the meet, as per the Swimming Wellington Photography Policy.
- 13. Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the start of the meet.
- 14. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Policy 008 accompanied with the \$100.00 cash.

Club / Spectator Information

- 1. There will be no allocated seating for this meet.
- 2. Spectator's entry fee will be \$3.00 for 16 years and over.
- 3.The SNZ Code of Conduct and Media and Photography position statement in the SNZ Member Protection Policy Manual apply to all swimmers, coaches, officials and spectators entering WRAC. The Manual can be found on the SNZ website **HERE**
- 4. Scratchings before the meet can be emailed to events@swimwn.co.nz by 5pm Thursday 27 March 2025. Withdrawals after this time are to be via a withdrawal form at the recorder's desk at the venue 45 minutes before the start of the meet.
- 5. Programmes will be made available online on the Swimming Wellington website by midday Friday28th March 2025 and on Meet Mobile. There will be no printed programmes available.
- 6. Entry for all swimmers, officials, team managers and coaches will be via the southern entrance. Swimmers to present Swimming Wellington pool entry passes. Coaches are to display their NZSCTA cards throughout the meet. Officials (including timekeepers and duty clubs volunteers) are required to sign in on entry. Doors open 4.30pm.
- 7. Entry for nominated Team Coaches & Team Managers will be; 1-10 Swimmers (2), 11-20 (4), 21-35+ (6).
- 8. Disqualifications will be announced, and can be viewed at the recorders desk.
- 9. All participating Swimming Wellington clubs are required to provide technical officials for the meet. RTOP will send this request to clubs. Officials to bring own water bottle.
- 10. There will be an Official's Meeting at 4.10pm.
- 11. The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.

Warm Up Procedure

Warm-up duration: 25 minutes

Lanes 1-9: General Swimming with only feet first entry applicable in all lanes.

Lanes 0/1 & 8/9: To become dive lanes at 4.15pm.

Lane 2: designated pace lane

Lane 0: General swimming (unless required by para swimmers) between 4.00 – 4.15pm.
