Meet Set Up

Meet will be swum short course under SNZ/World Aquatics rules except where local rules and conditions apply. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under WPS swimming rules.

All events will be swum as single age timed finals with over the top starts.

Self marshalling will operate throughout the meet.

Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ policy 008 along with \$100 cash.

All events (except relays) will be swum oldest to youngest, fastest to slowest and scored in the following age groups for both male & female:

50m & 100IM events: 12, 11, 10 & 9/U years

Relays

4 x 50m Mixed Medley Relay:

Maximum of 3 teams per club, 12 and under mixed - 2 boys and 2 girls.

Awards

Wellington Swimmers - The top 3 Wellington swimmers placing in each event will receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal.

Visitors - a maximum of 2 visitor medals will be awarded in any one event.

Ribbons - will be available for collection for swimmers finishing in the top 10 who did not receive a medal.

No medals or ribbons for relay event.

Medals will be presented at the end of the meet. Club uniform tops for medal presentations. Same gender substitutes permitted.

Age group points will be earned as 20, 14, 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for first to tenth inclusive.

Trophies will be awarded to Wellington Regional Clubs only:-

The Eyeline Cup - for the highest scoring Wellington Club in the 12&U age. Does not include relay event.

SW Junior Sprint Relay Cup - for fastest time recorded by a Wellington Club in the Relay Event 41.

SW Junior Sprint Challenge Swim Cap - for the highest scoring Swimming Wellington boy & girl of each age group - 9/u, 10, 11 & 12. Age group points are earned from the 50m free, breast, fly and back.

Entry Details

This meet is open to financial SNZ registered competitive and club swimmers aged 12 years and under. Overseas competitors may compete subject to providing a signed Travel Authorisation Form/Letter from their national federation.

Age as at 27th July 2024.

NT are allowed.

Entry fees are \$12.00 per event per swimmer. Except for Relays - there is no cost.

Entries and payment will be via the SNZ Database, pay later not an option.

Entries will open on Friday 21st June 2024.

Entries close at 23:59:59 (Midnight) on Monday 22nd July 2024. Late entries will NOT be accepted.

Relay entries must be emailed to the Events Manager louise@swimwn.co.nz by 9am Thursday 25th July 2024.

There will be no refunds for withdrawals after entries close.

Initial psych sheets will be posted on the website on Tuesday 23rd July and finalised programme on Friday 26th July 2024.

By entering this meet, swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington in accordance with the SNZ Member Protection Policy.

Swimming Wellington reserves the right to restrict entries and amend the programme and will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury that may occur at this meet.

All Participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.

Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a doctor or physio certificate and sighted by the Technical Director prior to the first session the strapping is applied.

Para Swimmers

Classified para swimmers (including those with provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet.

Para swimmers are requested to report to the Technical Director prior to the warm-up.

Warm-Up

Warm-up duration: - 30 minutes

First 20 minutes: - general warm-up (no dive lanes).

Feet first entry.

Lanes 1/2/3 & 5/6/7: - To become dive lanes for the

last 10 minutes of warm up **Lane 4:** - Designated pace lane

Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over lane ropes.

Club & Spectator Information

All participating Swimming Wellington clubs will be required to provide volunteers for hosts, runner, and medals. Swimming Wellington will send a request to all clubs. .

A seating plan will be published on the SW website on Wednesday 24th July 2024.

Programmes will be uploaded to the Swimming Wellington website on midday Friday 26th July 2024.

Entry for nominated team coaches & team managers will be limited to the following numbers: -

1 - 10 swimmers - 1 coach & 2 team managers

11- 20 swimmers - 2 coaches & 3 team managers

21 - 35+ swimmers - 3 coaches & 4 team managers.

Two (2) programmes for each club can be uplifted from the sign in desk on entry and will be available via wellingtonswimming.org.nz.

Entry for all swimmers, officials, team managers and coaches will be via the main entrance at Tawa Pool.

Swimmers and coaches to present Swimming Wellington pool entry passes. Coaches must display their NZSCTA cards throughout the meet, only swimmers and coaches with NZSCTA passes will be permitted to enter the coaches area.

Team Managers must show passes at the door.

Officials (including timekeepers and duty club volunteers) are required to sign in on entry.

Visiting clubs - please provide names of team managers and coaches to louise@swimwn.co.nz

The meet will be on Meet Mobile - these are unofficial until the referee has signed them off.

Disqualifications will be announced, and can be viewed / photographed at the recorders desk.

The Swimming NZ Code of Conduct and Media and Photography position statement in the Swimming NZ Member Protection Policy Manual apply to all competitors, volunteers and spectators entering CAC. The Manual can be found on the Swimming NZ website here.

There will be a team manager meeting by the Tawa Club rooms upstairs, 15 minutes before the start of warm-up, 3.45pm.

Officials information

All participating Swimming Wellington clubs are required to provide officials for this meet. RTOP will send this request to clubs. Qualified visiting officials are welcome and may apply via email RTOP@swimwn.co.nz.

All qualified officials are required to have a current SNZ police vet recorded on the SNZ database.

Officials to bring their own water bottles.

There will be an officials meeting in the Tawa Club rooms 20 minutes prior to the start of the meet, 5.15pm.
